Beak



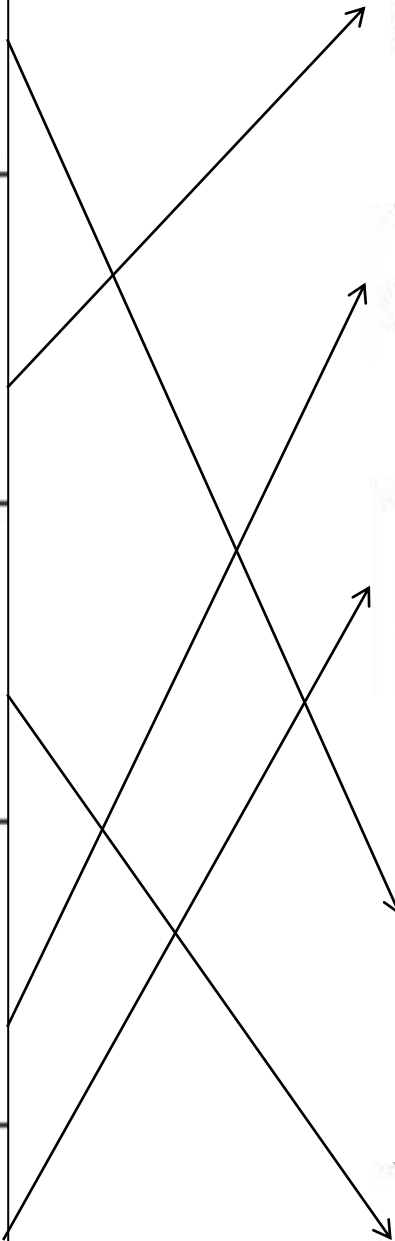
This shape helps crack nuts and seed and to tear fruits.

This shape helps it to catch fish and worms in the water.



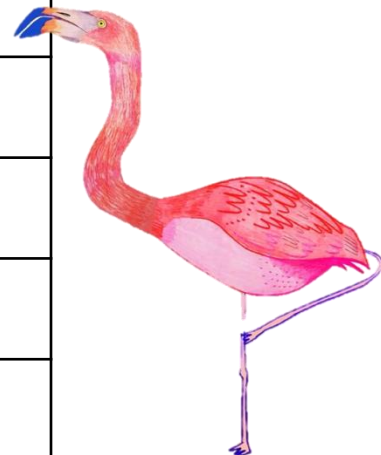
