Workbooks to be bought at school for 2020

Attached to this letter is the compulsory booklist for 2020. You will notice that some textbooks are bought at school. These are available ONLY at school at the cheapest possible cost. Orders have been done and paid for by the school. These books will be available to the learners at the start of the 2020 academic year.

All the other textbooks will be available at bookshops (specifically Protea Bookshop in Hatfield). Books should be purchased by end of November 2019 to prevent stock shortages in January 2020.

Second hand textbooks will be sold on 28 November at the school. Please ensure that it is one that your daughter needs for 2020 as some textbooks are new (as indicated on the booklist). Please note that the learners will be selling their books individually and therefore all transactions have to be cash as no credit card facility will be available.

Gr. 11 Compulsory Extra fees for 2020 is R300 which includes, amongst others, the yearbook, school diary, exam pads for tests/exams, speakers, end-of-year gift for Gift Mass, etc.

This extra fee must be paid by the end of January 2020 to Mrs Mbatsane (the cashier at the school entrance). These amounts will be reflected on your January 2020 statement.

Other costs:

Any new learner needs to buy a house T-shirt from the clothing shop. Learners will know in which house they have been placed next year January.

Please note that if your daughter is part of one of the following camps or is elected prefect, the cost is reflected. However, it is not compulsory unless your daughter forms part of the team. Letters will be sent out in 2020 with further details.
