

The gates in **Visagie Street** open for vehicles at **7h00**. If you drop your child before 7h00, they may walk through and line up to be screened. There are staff members already present from 6h30, and the children are supervised.

Please ensure that your child is **ready to exit** the vehicle as soon as you stop. If the children take too long to gather their belongings, it causes severe traffic congestion in Visagie Street and in the driveway. Thank you to all our parents for taking others into consideration!

The **Foundation Phase** (Crèche to Grade 3) finishes school at **13h10**, and the **Senior Primary** (Grade 4 to 7) finishes school at **13h30**.

The Visagie Street gates will open in the afternoon at **13h10**; please DO NOT come too early (before 13h10) as this creates problems with the traffic build-up in the street.


Parents with siblings in the school are reminded to please only come to fetch the children when the **oldest sibling finishes** school as there is no safe place to park and wait for the children in the school grounds. High School learners finish school at **14h00**.

- A reminder to **day care parents** of the service being offered by the tuck shop to prepare lunch for the learners. Please contact the tuckshop directly, Orlando, at 083 265 4768 with orders and payment.
- Please make sure that your child has all the **necessary items of uniform**. A reminder that the sports skirt may only be worn by Grade 4 to 7 girls. The Foundation Phase girls must please wear their blue sports shorts as part of their sports uniform. Please contact Mr Danny Venter on 083 658 9859 at the uniform shop to make an appointment should you need to purchase any items.
- Winter uniform must be worn as from 3 May. Tracksuits may be worn in winter on Phys-Ed days.
- Unfortunately, due to **COVID-19 regulations**, learners may not bring cake or party packs to school for their classmates on their birthday. Children, may, however, wear their home clothes on their birthday.
- Our first **Outreach programme** for the year has started. Our **Blanket Drive** has started. We are asking our very generous parents to donate a blanket that will be distributed to organisations that serve the needy in the community around the school. The blanket must please be a new one, although we do not expect our parents to buy very expensive blankets, only what you can afford. There will be an area where the children can leave the blankets when they are dropped off in the morning. Please take note that this is a voluntary donation and parents are by no means forced to make a contribution. The last day for bringing a blanket is Friday 16 April.
- A reminder that Loreto Convent School's **terms and holidays** now differ quite significantly from those of public schools. The first term comes to an end on **Friday 26 March** and school reopens on **Tuesday 13 April**. Reports for the first term will be issued after our return in April.
- **Extra lessons** will start in the Primary School on Monday 19 April.

- Foundation Phase teachers will be taking the children who need extra assistance after school, and will communicate directly with the affected parents.
- Senior Primary girls will receive a letter in the first week of school if they are required to attend extra lessons. These lessons will take place between 13h30 and 14h00 on days specified for the different subjects.
- Gordon Harris Photography will be coming to the school on Tuesday 20 April to take individual photos only. No sibling photos or class/group photos will be taken. All the children will sit for a photo and order forms will be sent home thereafter and parents can then decide whether or not to order the package. The package will cost R120 and will include a "class photo" which has been created from all the individual photos.
- The **Grade 6 and 7 girls** will be attending a **Mass** in the school hall on **Tuesday, 20 April**, at 7h45.
- It is with great sadness that we are **saying good bye** to one of our Senior Primary teachers at the end of this term. **Mrs Rochelle Fourie** is relocating to Stellenbosch in the Western Cape. Mrs Fourie started as a relief teacher at Loreto, and was appointed as a full-time teacher in July 2014. She has proved her versatility by teaching and specialising in a number of subjects over the years, including NS/Tech to Grade 5 and 6, RE, Phys-Ed to all the Primary School children, and more recently Maths in Grade 5 and Technology in Grade 7. Mrs Fourie has contributed many other talents and skills to Loreto, such as co-ordinating the dance routines for our last concert in 2015. She is an energetic and vibrant teacher whose

enthusiasm and dynamic personality will be sorely missed. Mrs Fourie, on behalf of the whole Loreto family, particularly the Primary School staff and learners, we wish you and your family all the best in Stellenbosch. We hope that you will be very happy and wish you success in all your future endeavours. Thank you for everything that you have brought to Loreto, and the legacy that you will leave behind. 




## HIGH SCHOOL

### **FINANCE MATTERS**

**Firstly,** we need to thank those parents who have faithfully been paying their school fees. In order for the School to stay operational, parents HAVE to pay their school fees on time. Loreto Convent School is not a State or no-fee paying school, and as such, we need to rely on the payment of school fees as the majority stream of income that must finance all expenses throughout the year.


Statements have been sent out to parents. If you are not receiving our bulk mails, please do let us know.

Please note that school fees are payable **UPFRONT**, by the **7<sup>th</sup> of every month**. This means that all fees, up to and including January/February 2021 fees are already due and payable in full. Overdue accounts will be followed up and handed over to our debt collection company for recovery. Please note that you will be liable for any **interest** on the account and collection and/or legal **fees**, should the account be handed over. **Overdue accounts will be charged an interest rate of 2% per month, as per our contract**. We are going to be very strict regarding the payment of fees in 2021.

We have a large number of payments that have been made into the school's bank account that do not have any references, or incorrect references. If you have made one of these payments, please do send your proof of payment to Mrs Swart at <a href="mailto:finance@loreto.co.za">finance@loreto.co.za</a> so that she can allocate it.

We would also like to appeal to parents to <u>PLEASE</u> reference their payments correctly, as it is almost impossible to allocate correctly, or understand what is being paid for when the references are missing or incorrect. Examples of such references are "School Fees", "Loreto Fees" or "Cash Payment" – it does not indicate who is making the payment or what is being paid.




The reference is your four-digit family code number, NOT the old family code or your surname or the child's name.

Please also do try to pay correct amounts, in this way, the system is able to allocate to the account automatically and mistakes are avoided.

















